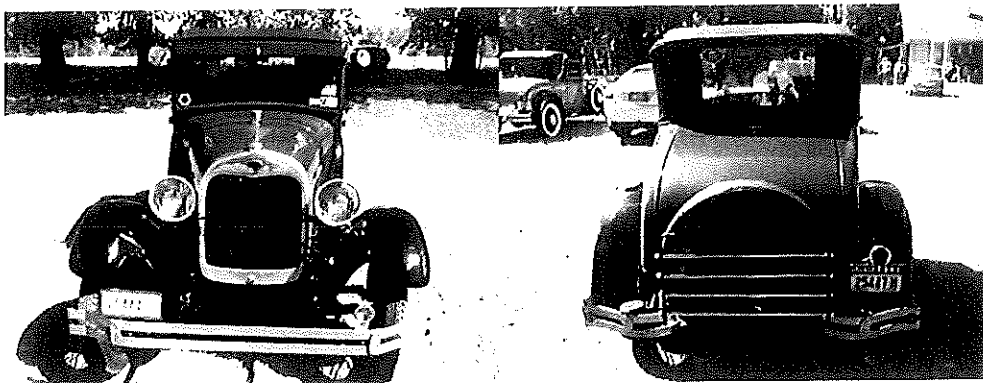

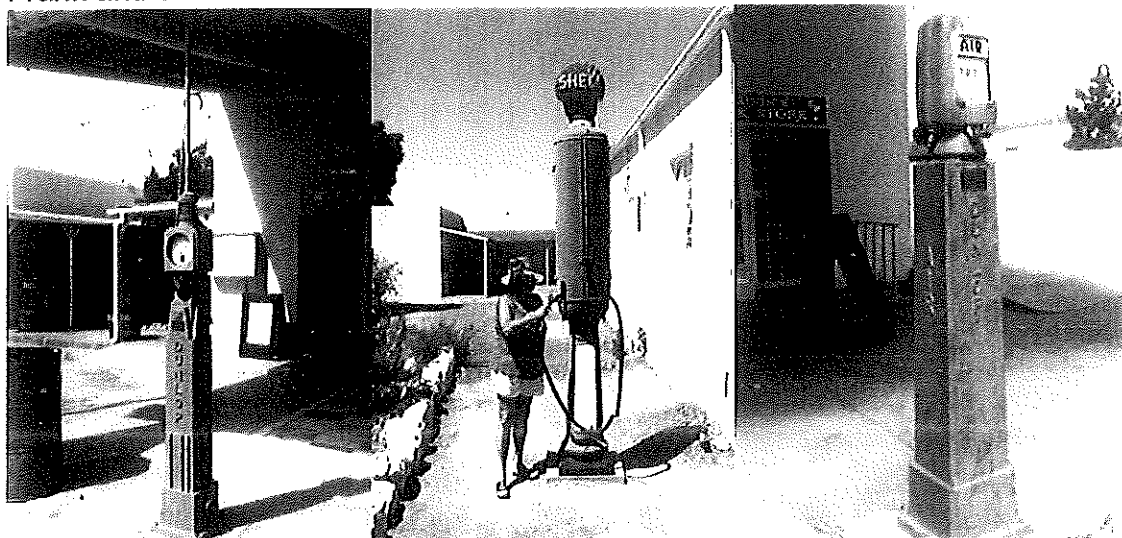

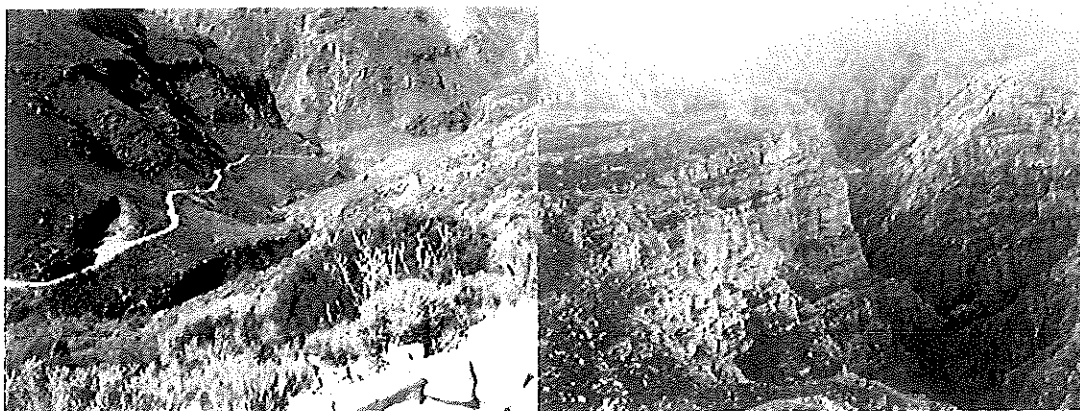

Having a great adventure here in South Africa. Cheers Frank and Sue.

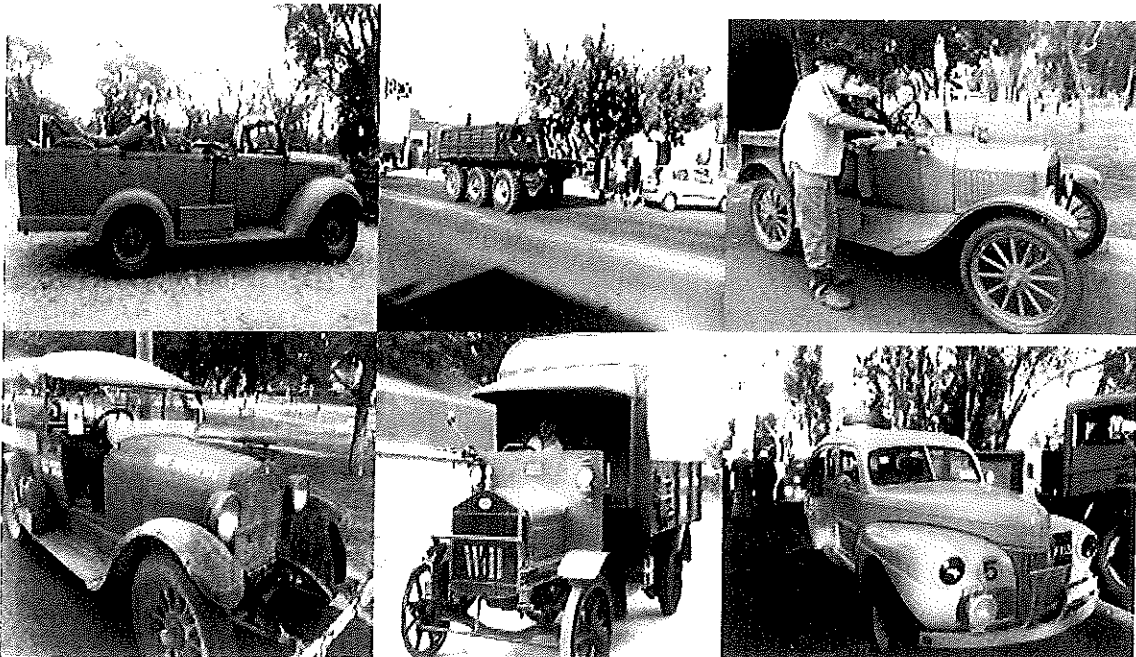
Neville Run 23.2.14

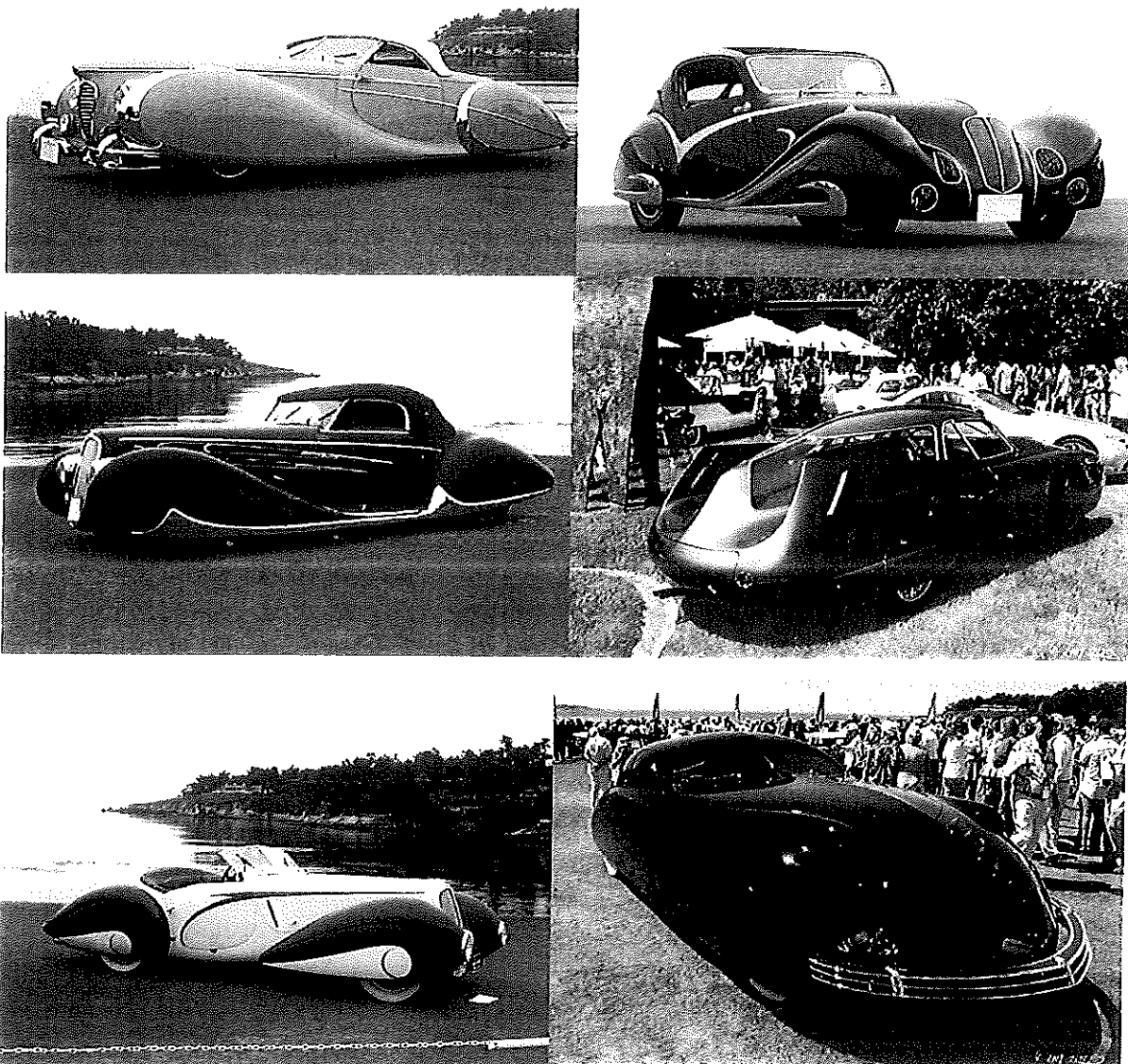

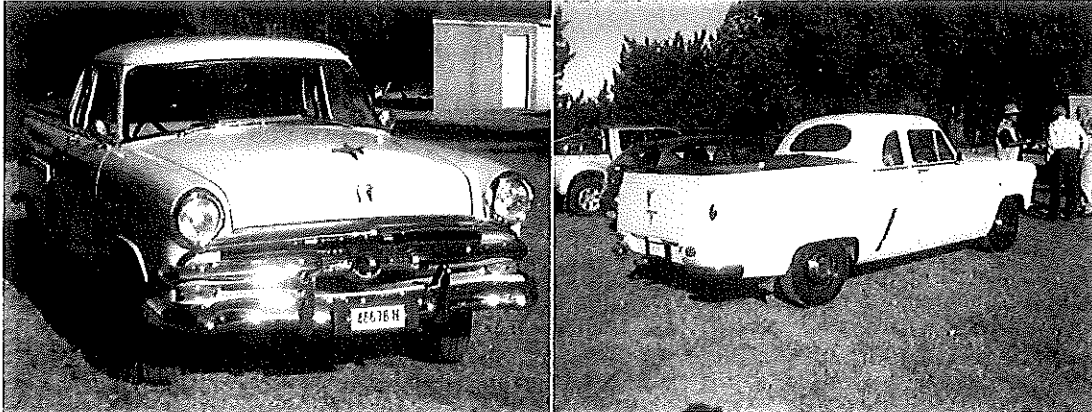
