Treasurer Bob Boaden presented and tabled the monthly financial statement and advised that some accounts for the Canobolas Country Rally were yet to be finalised in order that a final balance sheet can be produced. Questions and discussion invited. Two accounts presented for payment Wangarang \$119.90 magazine printing and Chris Bromley \$42.00 for magazine postage. Moved by Bob and 2nd Chris Bromley that the Wangarang account be checked prior to payment and Chris be reimbursed for postage costs. CARRIED.

Editor's report:

Chris Bromley reported on the changes he had made to the postage of the club magazine and apologized for his omission in the October magazine of the listing in the events for the Boomerang March. He is also lacking on suitable items from members for publication and would appreciate some help in this regard.

Events report:

John Streetfeild indicated whilst he did not wish to have the responsibility for the events co-ordinator for 2016 he was still desirous of being a member of that committee subject to being elected at the following AGM.

Bob McNeil gave some comment on the Kookaburra march from Mudgee which our club member Don Marriott was also a participant with his WW11 Jeep and trailer.

The under mentioned events were moved by Kevin Penson and 2nd Bob Boaden that they be added to list of authorized club runs. CARRIED.

General Business:

Some discussion was had on the log book scheme introduced from the 1/10/2015 and for those who have not caught up with the trial period should be made aware of the requirements so far as ODAMC is concerned.

For those wishing to remain on the current historic policy nothing has changed and your renewal of registration at the motor registry will follow past procedures.

For those wishing to opt into the log book scheme for the two year trial period and avail yourself of the 60 day unrestricted use of your vehicle, you will be required to advise the motor registry officer of your intention and that ODAMC is an authorized club as a participant in the trial period.

You are required to complete a "change of records RMS form", produce your current A5 purple "certificate of operations" , proof of ID and renewal of registration certificate.

Upon completion of this process you will be handed an A4 sized "log sheet" which will be your responsibility to complete for each daily journey although authorized club runs are apparently exempted but if unsure complete the sheet to be on the safe side of the law.

FINALLY PLEASE ADVISE OUR REGISTRATION OFFICER, BERNIE SCHELL THAT YOU HAVE OPTED FOR THE TRIAL LOG BOOK SCHEME SO THAT HE CAN UPDATE CLUB RECORDS.

In order to formalize the current club vehicle inspection procedures which are now basically in place, the following motion was put before the meeting for discussion.

" At the discretion of the club registration officer, a vehicle roadworthy certificate from an authorized Roads & Maritime Services inspection officer may be required in lieu of a club roadworthy inspection for any new application for conditional registration and at the renewal of a registration where the expiry date falls outside of the RMS 42 post period from the club registration day". Moved by Bruce Heinrich and 2nd by Kevin Penson. CARRIED

In explanation the club registration day this year is 29th November and in utilizing the 42 day RMS period which validates an inspection certificate issued on the club inspection day, vehicles with an expiry date up to 10th January 2016 can be inspected on the club inspection day. After that date the discretion of the club registration officer can be exercised as to whether an inspection by a club inspection officer will suffice or a

roadworthy certificate (previously known as a pink slip) will be required from an authorized RMS inspection officer.

A further topic for mention was whether the distance for servicing, maintenance or road testing runs for those vehicles not opting into the log book trial should be restricted in distance from the usual place of garaging or whether the current terminology in By-Law (6)(c)(iii) of a "justifiable distance" should remain.

This query arose from the recent half yearly CHMC meeting where Peter Wells the RMS Safety & Compliance Officer indicated that clubs should set a specific distance in this category from the usual place of garaging.

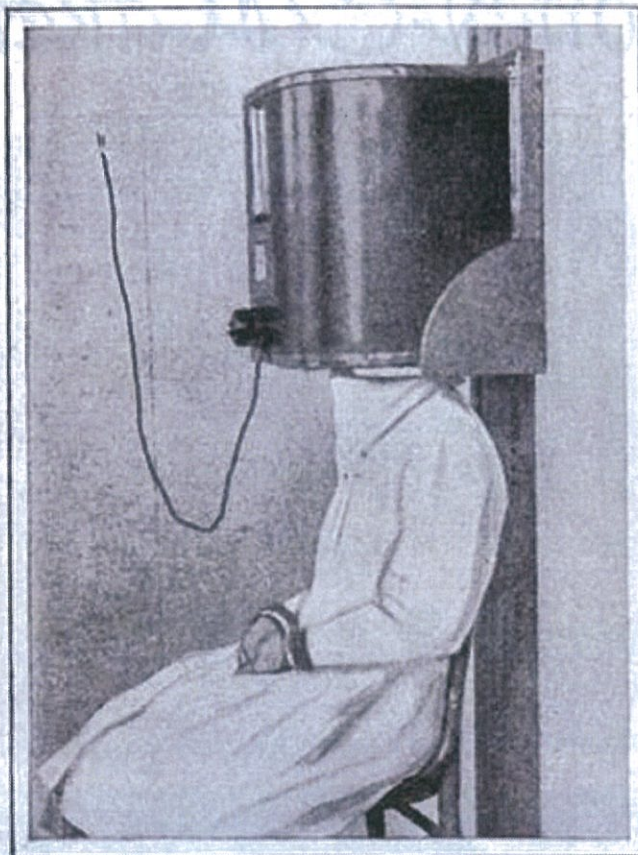
This subject has been stood over until the next meeting due to time restraints and further input from President Keith who was our delegate at the half yearly meeting.

Solar Bath Apparatus Helps Cure Diseases of the Head



NO, THE peculiar looking device in the photo at left is not a camera, nor even a telescope, although partially resembling both. It is a new solar bath apparatus for the head and has made a great hit with the medical fraternity of Germany. The main purpose of the device is to cure sicknesses of the head, like catarrh of the nose and throat or of the ears. It reposes on a stationary upright and has an opening in under side for a patient's head. Affected person sits in a chair while taking treatments. An ultra-violet ray machine within throws artificial sunlight upon all parts of the head. Eventually, when fully tested and improved, it is expected to cure many of the illnesses of the head.
