Editor's Report: Our editor Chris Bromley was absent due to other commitments but the meeting was reminded of those members desirous of having their club magazine emailed should advise accordingly as per the previous memo sent out by him.

Events Report: Peter Amos reported on past events including short run via Clergate to the R.H Hotel for lunch and the mid week run on a perfect day to Borenore Caves. Both were well supported he and reminded members of coming outings as per the Events Calendar in the magazine. He also advised that there are 62 entries to date for the

Autumn Tour for which plans were well in hand for a successful tour. A working bee is to be held at the Club House on Saturday 27th April to commence at 9am in preparation for the Autumn Tour and would like to see as many hands as possible to do their bit.

Keith Packham gave an overview of the successful Bush Council Rally at Merimbula and congratulated the Parkes Club on winning the Mal Mason Shield. The rally for next year will be hosted by the Parkes Club and entry forms are available at the club house. John Streetfeild favourably reported on the Morris Minor Rally as did Kevin Bowyer on the Austins over Australia, both being well attended.
