The annual club inspection day will be held on Sunday 27th November 2016 at the car club building starting from 8am.

Vehicles on conditional registration with the ODAMC with a registration expiry date between 27th November 2016 and 7th January 2017 will be inspected on this day. If you are unable to attend on the day then a certificate of road worthiness (Pink Slip) will be required for the vehicle.

The following documentation will need to be sighted and details recorded by the Registration Officer on the day.

- 1. Historic Vehicle Declaration (RMS form #1259) partially filled out.
- Registration Papers current or renewal.
- 3. Current certificate of Comprehensive Insurance.
- 4. Proof of Club Membership.
- 5. Certificate of Operations for the vehicle (Purple Form kept in the vehicle).

Note

The Historic Vehicle Declaration Form will not be signed off unless the above documentation is sighted and details recorded beforehand.

The annual inspection of vehicles on Conditional Registration outside of the expiry dates listed above may require either an ODAMC roadworthy check or a certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip). This will be at the discretion of the Registration Officer.

LOGBOOK. ABUSE IT AND LOOSE IT.

A club plate vehicle from another club was pulled over by police and when asked to produce the vehicles logbook the owner happily obliged with the appropriate entry for that day But when questioned about other specific dates, the driver was adamant that he hadn't entered those dates in the logbook because the vehicle had not been used .The policeman then produced a log of times, dates and places that the vehicle had been observed by the police (possibly plate recognition technology) it became obvious that driver had been fudging the his logbook. On closer inspection, the policeman noticed that the entries had been made in pencil and previous entries had been rubbed out and super ceded with a new one.

The logbook has been confiscated and the vehicle cannot be used as it no longer has a logbook. The owner is facing charges of driving an unregistered vehicle, falsifying documents and possibly attempting to pervert the course of justice. The Police are expected to apply to the courts for the forfeiture of the plates issued to the vehicle .It is possible that the club issuing the permit could be in trouble too. If the owner is convicted, there could be serious ramifications for the club permit scheme. The lesson is this, don't take chances when using your club plate vehicle.
