### **Annual Inspection Day**

The annual club inspection day will be held on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> November 2017 at the car club building starting from 8am.

Vehicles on conditional registration with the ODAMC with a registration expiry date between 26<sup>th</sup> November 2017 and 26<sup>th</sup> May 2018 will be inspected on this day. This is because the certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip) and the club safety checks are now valid for 6 months. If you are unable to attend on the day then a certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip) may be required for the vehicle.

The following documentation will need to be sighted and details recorded by the Registration Officer on the day.

- 1. Historic Vehicle Declaration (RMS form #1259) partially filled out.
- 2. Registration Papers current or renewal.
- 3. Current certificate of Comprehensive Insurance
- 4. Proof of Club Membership.
- 5. Certificate of Operations for the vehicle (Purple Form kept in the vehicle).

#### Note.

The annual inspection of vehicles on Conditional Registration outside of the expiry dates listed above may require either an ODAMC roadworthy check or a certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip). This will be at the discretion of the Registration Officer

The Historic Vehicle Declaration Form will **not** be signed off this year unless the above documents are sighted and details recorded by the Club Registration Officer beforehand.

Club members with vehicles on HCRS are reminded if their membership fees are not paid by the due date they are not financial members and their registration and CTP will be void! (ie the vehicle is unregistered and uninsured).

#### The 1960 Porsche 356B TS Super 90

The model is 1960 356B T5 Super90. Back in the day, these cars were often referred to as inverted bathtubs...hence the number plate TUB-356.

The engine is the original factory pushrod 1600 with the rare Super90 power option ie. 40mm carbs, large inlet valves and tiny exhaust valves. The transaxle is 4 speed with a very long overdrive 4th gear. Factory guaranteed top speed was 115mph at 5600rpm.

While delivered as a factory RightHandDrive in early 1960 in Australia, it would have been manufactured mainly in 1959.

I have known this car since 1982 when I started up The Australian 356 Register. An old mate of mine, Arno Leinas, owned the car from 1961 through to 2012. Arno and Peg never missed a 356 run and he enjoyed people constantly offering to buy his car. Arno was a sound engineer at the Sydney Opera House. The car had its' own parking spot under the stairs of the Opera House for decades....the parking sticker is still on the windscreen.

The car caused a lot of interest at auction due to the engine option and the x5 factory installed Rudge (knock-off) wheels. It sold at 60% over the auctioneers estimate to a Melbourne dealer who asset stripped the wheels and sold them on eBay for USD50k. The car was then restored using factory original parts which I supplied and put on the market. I "one for one" swapped a 1958 Porsche 356A Speedster rust bucket, which I had owned since 1983, for the restored Super90.

These cars, in the 1950s, had a reputation for being 'tail happy'...so, with the release of the slightly updated 1960s body, the factory softened the rear torsion bars to provoke understeer and installed a compensator spring across the rear to prevent suspension sag when carrying passengers in the rear seats.

The brakes are eleven inch alloy drums all around.....Porsche was the last sports car manufacturer to drop drums for discs.....they relented for marketing reasons only....not because the drums were not good enough. The Chev Corvette of this era weighed double that of the 356 but had half of the swept area in the drums. The 356GT drums were another 20% bigger than standard ones.

The cars were handmade (a lot of lead) so, the doors, bonnet and engine lid were stamped with the last 3 digits of the chassis number to ensure true fit, after the paint shop....the purist collectors of today put a high premium on cars with "matching numbers".

The Super90 engine had a bad reputation for being fussy when driven at town speeds but came alive over 50mph. With the efficiencies that we enjoy from modern fuels, the tuning of these engines while producing even more power also deliver much improved fuel efficiency also more torque at lower revs....The most obvious change being that the float level is now set a 7mm lower than 1950/60 levels.

It is now a joy to drive around town as well out on the open road. Regards Lance




