There was some agreement from the floor, but there was also some willingness by members to pay a supplement to revert to the old position of printed, posted magazines. Bruce acknowledged that it was for a trial period of three months and after lots of discussion it was agreed that another meeting of the executive would take place to review the matter and report at the March meeting.

Members were referred to the December minutes where the position of the Club’s Finances were outlined to members and a motion passed to trial the present Magazine arrangements as a cost saving measure.

Bruce Heinrich reported on work in progress at the Clubrooms. The drain repair under the concrete was proceeding again, there was a clean-up required, and repairs to the fences, after the trees were felled by Council along our fence line. Bruce also said that when the time came we should apply for a grant to remove the large tree near our gate which was old and dangerous. Bruce also said we should look into renewing the gas heaters in the Clubhouse.

A member reported that the new Historic Plates will begin with a “J” and not “H” as at present.

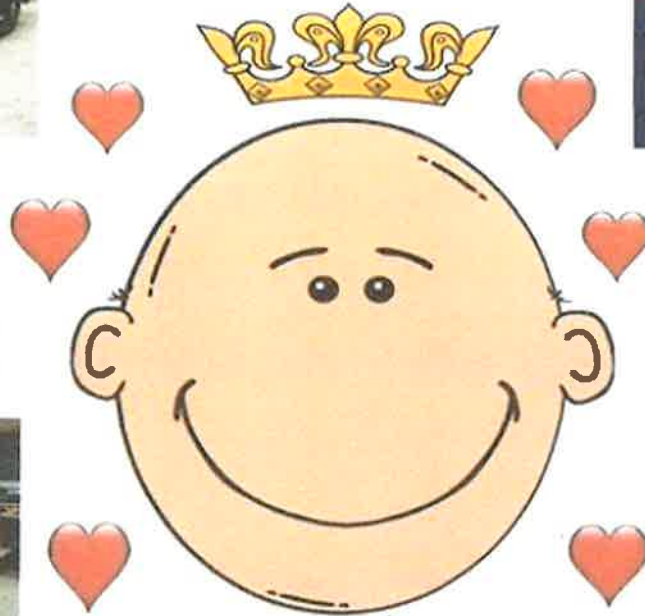
