Minutes of Monthly Meeting

Minutes of All ODAMC Elected Officials

19 th October 2020

We live in very different times and as this is bound to continue for some time, this meeting was convened to resolve some pressing issues facing the Club. We are restricted to 20 people maximum (now 30 from 24th October) on the property and it was felt that to get the widest representation of views we called for the attendance to all elected Officials of the Club. It was not the intention to exclude any Members. Any Members view is welcomed by Committee at any time.

The Nomination form for the AGM is attached and if there are any more Nominations please forward to the Secretary by the time of the AGM.

Meeting opened at 7.30 by President John Nicholson with 16 members present as per signing book.

1. AGM. 14th November 2020

After discussions, it was proposed to have an open-air meeting, where we are allowed maximum 30 people on the property, on November 14th, commencing at 9am.

Secretary will collect names in advance and if there are more than 27 members (excluding the executive) who wish to attend, a second meeting will be held at 11am. There is an implied right of access by all members to any full CLUB meeting. The main business will be to:

- a. Confirm Elected Officials for 2021.
- b. Confirm that Annual Fees will remain at \$50 for 2021.
- c. Confirm Minutes of last AGM.

All position's nominations have been confirmed, proposed and seconded. In the unlikely event that there is another nomination, another issue is raised, or there is a nomination voted down by one meeting a ballot will be conducted by email or mail to members to resolve the issue.

Treasurer will be available to collect Annual Fees for 2021 on the Day

Proposed: Euan Coutts Seconded: Keith Packham Carried.

2. Inspection Day 29th November 2020

Bob McNeil has proposed to organize his team of Scrutineers to visit various areas, (such as Blayney) and to Members who have multiple cars, to carry out annual inspections, in order to minimize the numbers at the Clubrooms (which are restricted to 30 people) on the 29th November.

Further, on Inspection Day at the Clubrooms, Marshalls will be on duty to assist with Inspections flow.

Treasurer will be available to collect Annual Fees for 2021.

Proposed: Keith Packham Seconded: Chris Bromley Carried.

3. CHMC Matters

Keith Packham reported that the new Inspections guidelines have issued from the RMS which allow for many modifications to vehicles on H plates, which we would not normally accept. After discussion it was felt we should keep to our own standards.

Proposed: Chris Bromley Seconded: Kevin Penson Carried.

4. Pre'31 Rally 2022

It is our Club 's turn to hold the Rally in 2022 and it was proposed to fix the date so that we do not clash with a proposed National Veteran Club Rally and so that we can begin our approach to the National Trust for sponsorship. Dates proposed are 29th, 30th April and 1st May.

Proposed: Kevin Penson Seconded: Richard Bloomfield. Carried.

5. Membership and Events.

Keith Packham reported that we have had two applications for membership pending for some time. He reported that he had inspected both vehicles which are acceptable. He proposed that we accept these applications and suspend the requirement of attending two meetings or outings previous to Membership. The requirement of attending two outings or meetings per year after membership would remain.

Applicants are: Katrina Catanzarariti with a 1974 Leyland Mini Proposed: Keith Packham Sec: John Lee.

Enrico (Ric) Pasquali with a 1982 Holden utility. Proposed: Kerry Risstrom.
Sec: Keith Packham.

Concern was expressed that our Club may be being used to merely obtain H Registration but Keith reported that he judged this not to be the case. Applications approved on the above basis.
Prop: Keith Packham. Sec: Kevin Penson. Carried.

A question arose as what period the fees paid today by the Applicants would cover, as there were very few events. After discussion it was proposed that the fees cover until 31/12/21

Proposed: Euan Coutts sec: Kevin Penson. Carried.

There was discussion concerning the future of the Canobolas Country Rally which is due to be held in October 2021 as there were very few entries last time. It was decided to leave the matter for the incoming Committee.

There is no event for 22nd November and it was decided to have an Events Committee meeting to decide on this event. There was discussion on the format of the Christmas Party and in view of the uncertainty and short notice almost certainly it would have to be held at the Clubrooms. Events Committee to formulate.

6. Treasurer's Matters.

Treasurer reported after consultation with other executive members he had paid the Public Risk Insurance, professional Indemnity and Product Liability Insurance \$ 645.08, Water Rates \$ 69.63, Elgas \$35.20 and Postage \$44. The Affiliation fees for the CHMC \$ 69 are due. It was proposed that meeting agree to these expenses

In view of the present conditions it was proposed that future regular accounts be paid at discretion of the Treasurer.

Proposed: Peter Amos Sec: Chris Bromley. Carried.

There was a question as to the renewal of the term deposit and Bruce Heinrich alluded to a number of repairs in the near future.

Viz: Concreting, shelves in the store room, replacing Gas heaters, and it was moved that we reduce the term deposit to \$10,000, with interest added to the deposit, and transfer the remainder, some \$3,000 to the working account to cover these expenditures in the future.

Prop: Bruce Heinrich Sec: Dick Jane. Carried.

Treasurer undertook to have final accounts prepared and audited for the AGM, and stated he would be available to collect fees at both AGM and Inspection Day.

Annual Inspection Day

The Annual Club Inspection Day will be held on Sunday 29th November 2020 at the Car Club Building starting from 8.30am.

Vehicles on conditional registration with the ODAMC with a registration expiry date between 29th November 2020 and 29th May 2021 will be inspected on this day. This is because the certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip) and the club safety checks are now valid for 6 months. If you are unable to attend on the day then a certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip) may be required for the vehicle.

The following documentation will need to be sighted and details recorded by the Registration Officer on the day.

1. Historic Vehicle Declaration (RMS form #1259) partially filled out.
2. Registration Papers Current or renewal.
3. Current certificate of Comprehensive Insurance.
4. Proof of Club Membership.
5. Certificate of Operations for the vehicle (Purple Form kept in the vehicle).

Note

The annual inspection of vehicles on Conditional Registration outside of the expiry dates listed above may require either an ODAMC roadworthy check or a certificate of roadworthiness (Pink Slip). This will be at the discretion of the Registration Officer. The Historic Vehicle Declaration Form will not be signed off unless the above documents are sighted and details recorded by the Club Registration Officer beforehand.

Club members with vehicles of HCRS are reminded if their membership fees are not paid by the due date, they are not financial members and their registration and CTP will be void! (I.e. the vehicle is unregistered and uninsured).

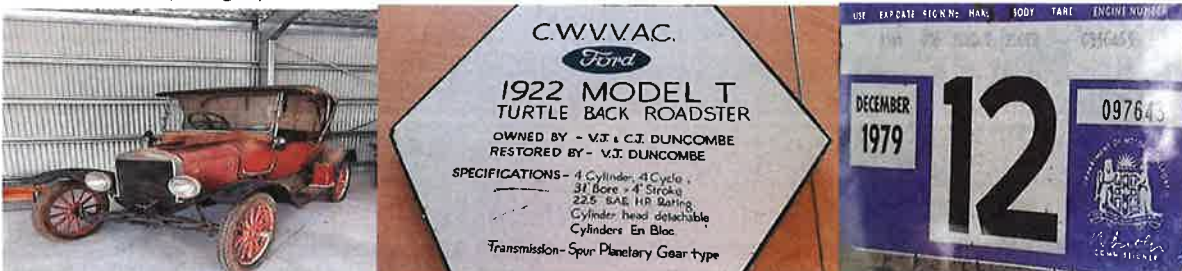
