Their skills are truly amazing and eye for detail unbelievable. Each artist has an A4 copy of what they are to paint and they reproduce their work to a much larger scale.


In the painting to celebrate 100 years of the Eugowra Rugby Club it shows past captains of successful teams. This mural will be on display at the Eugowra Rugby Club.


